Application Guidelines: 2025 Social Practice Expo

This event aims to promote the integration of classroom learning with social action. It will showcase outstanding student projects from the past two academic years that encourage both faculty and students to step outside the comfort zone of higher education and create a deeper social impact. The key details are as follows:

I. Eligibility

Teams must be composed of students and faculty from the three universities of the NTU System: National Taiwan University of Science and Technology, National Taiwan Normal University, and National Taiwan University. The team leader must be a currently enrolled student at one of these three schools. Other team members can include graduates of these universities. Full-time or part-time faculty members can serve as advisors.

• Grand Prize: A grant of NT\$105,000 per team (1 team)

• Excellence Award: A grant of NT\$84,000 per team (2 teams)

• Merit Award: A grant of NT\$63,000 per team (3 teams)

V. Participant Subsidies

Teams that pass the preliminary review will receive a subsidy of up to **NT\$2,000** to cover material costs for their final exhibition. Detailed information will be sent to accepted teams separately. The organizers can provide proof of participation to help team members with leave requests.

VI. Grant Distribution

The prize money will be issued as a grant to the team representative, who is responsible for distributing it among the team members. The organizers will not mediate any disputes regarding the distribution of funds.
